CIRCULAR

Subject: Notice to persons acting on behalf of interested parties in an anti-dumping investigation.

1. Any person including a consultant/attorney/counsel/associate/firm who intends to act on behalf of any exporter/foreign producer or their trade or business association in an anti-dumping investigation before the National Tariff Commission under the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2000 shall provide the Commission a power of attorney, which meets the following requirements:

- a. The power of attorney shall be duly executed by the authorized representative/person of the exporter/foreign producer.
- b. The power of attorney shall be notarized by a notary public in the country where executed at the time of execution.
- c. The power of attorney shall be legalized/authenticated by the Pakistan Consulate in the country where executed.
- d. The power of attorney shall be in English language.

2. In case of person who intends to act on behalf of the applicant, the importers or their trade or business association, except for the requirement at paragraph 1(c) above, all the other requirements for a power of attorney setout in paragraph 1 shall apply.
