Notice of Impending Expiry of Antidumping Duties imposed on Dumped Imports of Certain Uncoated Writing / Printing Paper into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from Brazil, China, Indonesia, Japan and Thailand

The National Tariff Commission (the “Commission”), after making an affirmative final determination in terms of Section 39 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the “Act”) imposed definitive anti-dumping duties on dumped imports of Certain Uncoated Writing and Printing Paper of weight not less than 50 g/m² and not more than 130 g/m², containing 100 percent by weight of fibers, made from wood (“Certain Paper”) falling under PCT Codes 4802.5510, 4802.5600, 4802.5700, 4802.6100 and 4802.6200 into Pakistan originating in and/or exported from Federative Republic of Brazil, People’s Republic of China, Republic of Indonesia, State of Japan and Kingdom of Thailand (the “Exporting Countries”) at the duty rates from 1.64% to 39.10% of C&F value in *ad val.* terms till March 29, 2023.

In terms of Section 58(2) of the Act, it is hereby notified that the definitive anti-dumping duties levied on dumped imports of Certain Paper in and/or exported from the Exporting Countries shall terminate on March 30, 2022 unless a review under Section 58(3) of the Act is initiated before the date of termination of the duty. Domestic industry producing Certain Paper may file a sunset review application with the Commission on the prescribed form within forty-five days of the publication of this notice, if it so wishes. The sunset review application form may be obtained from the Commission.
