Notice of Initiation of Anti-dumping Investigation against Alleged Dumped Imports of Polyvinyl Chloride Resin - Suspension Grade into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from the Republic of Indonesia and United States of America

National Tariff Commission (the “Commission”) has received an application under Section 20 and 24 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015, (the “Act”) on March 26, 2026, from M/s. Engro Polymer & Chemical Limited, Karachi (the “Applicant”). The Applicant is a producer of Polyvinyl Chloride Resin - Suspension Grade (“PVC Resin”). The Applicant has alleged that PVC Resin is being exported to Pakistan at dumped prices from the Republic of Indonesia and United States of America (the “Exporting Countries”). According to the Applicant, the alleged dumped imports of PVC Resin from the Exporting Countries have caused material injury to the domestic industry producing PVC Resin.

Upon initial examination and scrutiny of the information and evidence provided in the application, in accordance with Section 23 of the Act, the Commission is satisfied that the information and evidence provided in the application is sufficient to justify the initiation of this investigation.

Initiation of Investigation: The Commission hereby initiates an anti-dumping investigation pursuant to Section 23 of the Act. The investigation will determine whether PVC Resin originating in and/or exported from the Exporting Countries is being dumped into Pakistan and whether such dumping has caused material injury to the domestic industry within the meaning of provisions of the Act. The Commission, during the course of this investigation, will seek further information/data from the interested parties deemed necessary for the purposes of this investigation.

Product under Investigation: The product allegedly being dumped into Pakistan is Polyvinyl Chloride Resin - Suspension Grade (the “investigated product”). The investigated product is classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff (“PCT”) No. 3904.1090.

Period of Investigation (POI): For determination of dumping and injury, the POI is as follows:

For determination of dumping:	From January 01, 2025 to December 31, 2025
For determination of injury:	From January 01, 2023 to December 31, 2025

All interested parties are invited to submit their views/comments/ documents/evidence (if any) not later than 45 days of the date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan. Written submissions provided by interested parties on a confidential basis must be marked “Confidential” and in accordance with Section 31 of the Act, shall be accompanied by a non-confidential version/summary, which will be placed in the public file. Date of initiation of investigation:	The date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan.
Date of preliminary determination:	Not earlier than 60 days and not later than 180 days from the date of initiation of the investigation.
Date of final determination:	Within 180 days of the date of publication of notice of preliminary determination in the press in Pakistan

Public File: In accordance with Rule 7 of the Rules, the Commission has established and maintained a public file at its office, which shall be available to interested parties for review and copying from Monday to Thursday between 1100 hours to 1300 hours (except public holidays) throughout the investigation.
